



1.) When a person is born again, the Holy Spirit moves in.

I Corinthians 6:19-20

- When you are born again, God breathes His Holy Spirit into you, and you become spiritually alive .

John 20:22

* You cannot be saved without the Holy Spirit moving in.

Romans 8:9-11

2.) The baptism in the Holy Spirit is a separate encounter from salvation.

* The indwelling of the Holy Spirit is not the same as the baptism in the Holy Spirit.

* The baptism of the Holy Spirit is an important step in your spiritual growth after you are saved.

- The purpose of the baptism in the Holy Spirit is to empower us to be who we are called to be and to be able to do what we are called to do.

Acts 1:8; Luke 24:49

* Everywhere in the book of Acts that someone is baptized in the Holy Spirit, we see that they are already saved or born again.

Acts 2:1-4; Acts 2:37-39; Acts 8:14-17; Acts 9:17; Acts 10:44-47; Acts 19:1-7

Conclusion:

* **The baptism in the Holy Spirit is not required for salvation, but it should be seen as an essential gift for every believer.**

- **Every believer is a candidate to be baptized in the Holy Spirit.**
