Session 6: “You Must Be Born Again”

John 3:1-15

- To truly be saved is to be “born again”.
- * There are some things that we need to understand about being “born again”.

1. You must be born again to enter the kingdom of God

- * Unless a person is “born again” (born from above), that person is not saved and will not make it to heaven.
- We cannot have eternal life if we remain in a sinful state.

2. It is a work of the Holy Spirit

- * Jesus is speaking of a supernatural experience or a spiritual birth.

John 3:6 (NLT); John 1:12-13

- * Before you are saved, your spirit man is dead.

Ephesians 2:1; Ephesians 2:4-5

- When a person is born again, God breathes His Holy Spirit into them, and they become spiritually alive.

John 20:22

- * When you are born again, the Holy Spirit begins to live in you.

I Corinthians 6:19-20

3. You are made new

- * Being born again or born from above speaks of a brand-new life.
- * When you are born again, your spirit is made brand new.

II Corinthians 5:17

- Before we are born again, we are in bad shape.

Ephesians 2:1-3

- * When we are born again, we take on a new identity – the identity of Christ.

I Corinthians 6:9-11

- “sanctified” – to make holy; to set apart as holy; purify
- “justified” – to make righteous; cleared of all charges related to their sins

Conclusion:

- * When you are born again, your spirit is made new and then God will change you from the inside out.
