Submission

James 4:4-7

Key words:

- “submit” – to arrange under; be subject to; to yield to one’s admonition; to obey
- “Lord” – master; supreme in authority; a person exercising absolute ownership rights

(Lord speaks of Jesus’ position in our lives.)

HOW TO PUT SUBMISSION TO GOD INTO PRACTICE IN YOUR LIFE:

- Recognize that Jesus is to be Lord of your life and yield to His authority in every area daily.
- Know what God’s will is for your life by studying God’s Word and listening to the Holy Spirit.
- Whenever you find yourself rebelling against His authority, repent and get back on track.
