“sanctify” – make holy; purify; to consecrate; to dedicate; to separate

INSTANTANEOUS

I Corinthians 6:11

When we are born again, we are instantly declared to be sanctified and justified or in right standing with God.

PROGRESSIVE

The work of sanctification is also progressive, in that, from the moment we are born again we are being made more and more like Christ as we turn from sin and submit our lives to God.
