Session Six: Signs Leading Up To the Rapture

Matthew 24:1-14

1.) Spiritual _____ (*verses 4-5*)

- “deceive” – to lead astray; to wander or get off course
- We must be grounded in the Bible.

I Timothy 4:1-2; II Timothy 4:2-4; Isaiah 5:20

2.) _____ and rumors of wars (*vs. 6*)

- “alarmed” – troubled; wanting to cry aloud or scream in terror
- Christ’s followers can walk in the peace of God.

Isaiah 26:3

3.) _____ will rise against nation (*vs. 7*)

- Ethnic groups, religious groups and ruling parties will clash with one another.

4.) _____ (*vs. 7*)

- Famines could also allude to economic struggles around the world or financial instability.
- Christ’s followers do not need to fear these things because God will take care of us.

Luke 21:11

- This speaks of multiple diseases that would appear.
- The child of God does not need to fear sickness or disease.
