WHO WILL BE TAKEN IN THE RAPTURE?

*Titus 2:11-14*

2.) Those living \_\_\_\_\_ lives.

- “self-controlled” – soberly; with sound mind (a disciplined life)

- “upright” – righteously

- “godly” – opposite of ungodliness

- When we say “No” to ungodliness, we say “Yes” to godly living.

- We must be separated from evil.

- Separation begins with repentance.

- We cannot be born again unless we repent of sin.

- “repent” a change of mind that leads to a change of action

- We are called to be holy.

*I Peter 1:13-16; Romans 12:1-2; II Corinthians 6:16-18; II Corinthians 7:1*

- “holy” – different; set apart; separate

A.) Living holy is not our attempt to become \_\_\_\_\_.

B.) Living holy is the \_\_\_\_\_ of righteousness.

- Jesus is coming back for a remnant that is truly set apart unto Him.

*II Peter 3:11, 14, 17; Ephesians 5:25-27*

3.) Those \_\_\_\_\_ for Christ to return.

*Titus 2:13; Luke 18:8*

- “wait” – expect; to receive in a personal manner; to welcome
